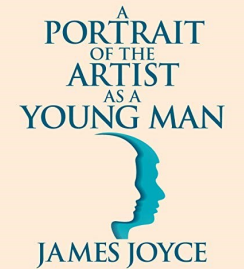


BLOOMSDAY NORTHAMPTON UK 2023
